
## Indoor bill announced in Camden

Latin balladeer Luis Miguel opens the theater Oct. 6. Other shows range from ballet to rock.

A fall bill ranging from ballet to country music will begin Oct. 6 at Camden's Waterfront Entertainment Centre. It will be the first indoor season for the arena, which can be expanded to seat 7,000 or enclosed to seat 1,700.

Arena officials also confirmed the appearance of pop star David Bowie, who will perform there on Sept. 22. His opening act will be Nine Inch Nails. No sale date for tickets has been set.

The inaugural season of the arena's winter configuration — the 1,700-seat Walter Land Theatre was announced by general manager Dominic Roncace at a news conference there yesterday; the entertainment center, now hosting summer events at full capacity, was reconfigured to its small size for the media event. The fully enclosed theater will debut Oct. 6 when Latin pop balladeer Luis Miguel will headline. Chuck Heuisler, chairman of the

## Review: Music

# O'Riordan, Cranberries had crowd singing along

Dolores O'Riordan's songs are tailor-made for sing-alongs in large, open spaces — the words offer emotional catharsis, the hooks are easy and memorable, and there are quirky, wordless vocal phrases (like the instantly recognizable dee-dodat-doo of "Ode To My Family") that repeat regularly.

But O'Riordan's songs also depend upon her reed-thin voice, and Tuesday at Camden's Waterfront Entertainment Centre, the Cranberries' leader held a sing-in that positioned her voice atop a mass choir some 20,000 strong. Without shouting, without saying a word, O'Riordan whipped the impromptu chorale into shape for the hit "Linger" and tested its lung power with the hard-hitting set-closer "Zombie."

In between, the tiny O'Riordan who entered wearing a little black dress and cape that contrasted with her blood-red hair — demonstrated that she's also capable of some sub-

Playing a church-organ setting on synthesizer, she created a prayerlike calm for "Electric Blue" that was enhanced by her fragile vocal pronouncements. She ended the emotional roller-coaster "Not Sorry" by reciting the golden rule, and sounded defeated — as though following it was too much to expect.

If she projected a veteran's confidence on the familiar hits, she doubled it to sell three new songs. One, "I Just Shot John Lennon," turned on a slippery, vaguely samba-style vamp that contrasted with its serious theme; another, the rousing "Free To Decide," captured the anthemic righteousness of Joshua Tree-era U2.

The three other Cranberries were all chords and no charm. They pro-

vided faceless, workmanlike support for O'Riordan's rants, and though they did develop musical textures that mirrored the intensity of the vocals, they were unable to match her extremes: the music rarely diminished to a whisper or swelled enough to support her full roar.

While the Cranberries have, in the last two years, developed into a potent performance machine capable of holding the crowd's attention between hits, the equally musical Toad the Wet Sprocket galvanized the crowd only when playing its wellknown radio songs. Everything else sounded competent, but dull.
