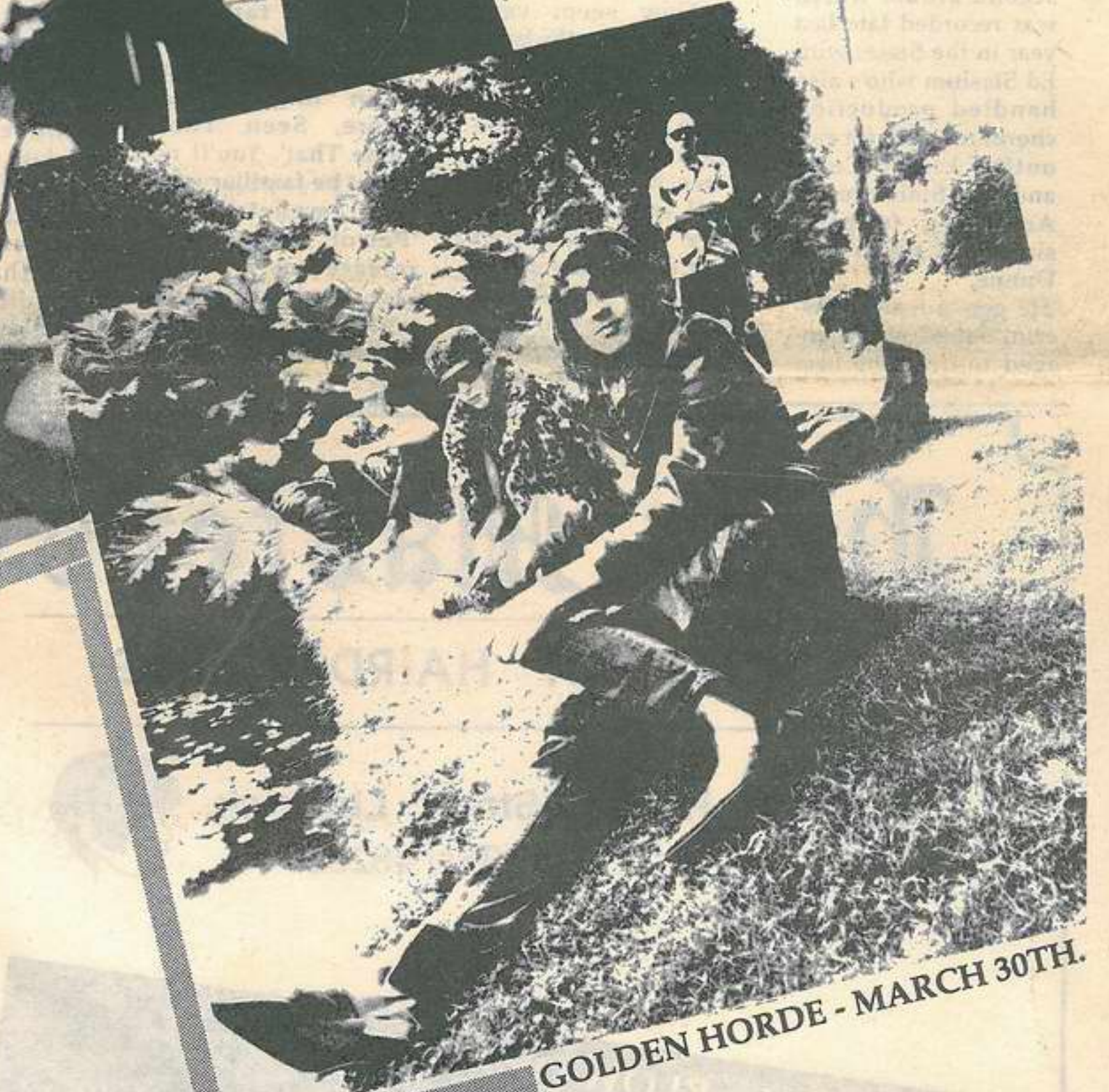

will feature prominently in the impressive calendar of events.

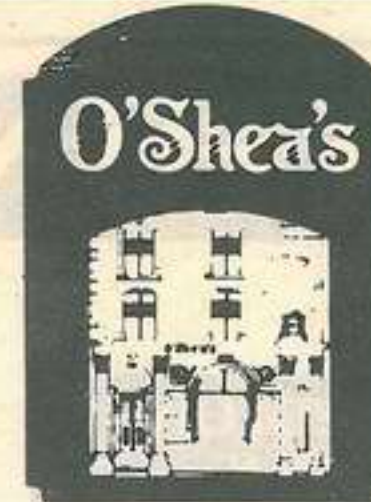
