Taoiseach lauds Eli Lilly

Kinsale firm celebrates

SOUTH West Cork's biggest employer, Eli Lilly S.A., "the company that makes products for the improvement of human health in an environmentally friendly way" hosted over 2,500 visitors last week in four days of celebration to mark the tenth anniversary of production at its huge and impressive Dunderrow, Kinsale plant.

Guest of honour at a special function last Thursday was An Taoiseach, Mr Charles J. Haughey T.D. who described Eli Lilly as "one of the world's most respected pharmaceutical and health-care companies which has been operating for well over 100 years."

"The coming to Ireland of Eli Lilly has undoubtedly enhanced Ireland's position as an important centre of the pharmaceutical industry. To-day, Eli Lilly's Irish plant is a highly successful operation. Investment on the Dunderrow site now totals nearly £70 million and the plant employs 310 people, mostly in highly skilled occupations."

Beginning with Pfizer in Ringaskiddy, con-

tinued Mr Haughey, Cork has created a strong base in this sector over the past twenty years: "At present, there are over thirty major chemical companies in County Cork, employing 3,500 people directly and with a significant economic spin-off."

'No bad publicity' opines Eoghan H.

Interviewed in Skibbereen

IN a quiet moment between the press reception, where he agonised over "mob hysteria" by political reporters, and the campaign launch, where he triumphantly claimed "there is no such thing as bad publicity," Eoghan Harris smiled defiantly as he confided

to one party-faithful: "I am the human sacrifice at the moment."

At the launch of the party's local election campaign for the

Schull and Skibbereen Electoral Areas at the West Cork Hotel on Monday night, Mr Harris said: Fine Gael won't

Cobh wants full service

COBH Urban Council has pledged itself not to rest until a full rail service is restored to the town. Councillors agreed unanimously at their May meeting that they would continue to pressure Iarnrod Eireann until the company acceded to their demands.

In a letter to the UDC, Mr C. J. Waters managing director of the rail company, reiterated the official viewpoint: uneconomic, off-peak services would be withdrawn. This includes the replacement of the late night train by a bus service. Mr Waters said however, that "the situation will be continuously monitored and reassessed."

Mr Kevin Foster said that what angered him most was that Iarnrod

Eireann gave economics as the reason for curtailing Cobh's rail service.

A LOSS

"They say that services have to run at a profit - yet they subsidise the DART to the tune of millions. They built the DART, at a cost of £760 m knowing it would run at a loss. In other words, it's regarded as a social service."

The chairman, Mr Con Lynch agreed: "The DART loses £20 m a year yet they will not give Cobh the £80,000 annually which would keep the service up to standard."

He also accused the company of "manipulating" the train service so as to make it unattractive for reassessed."

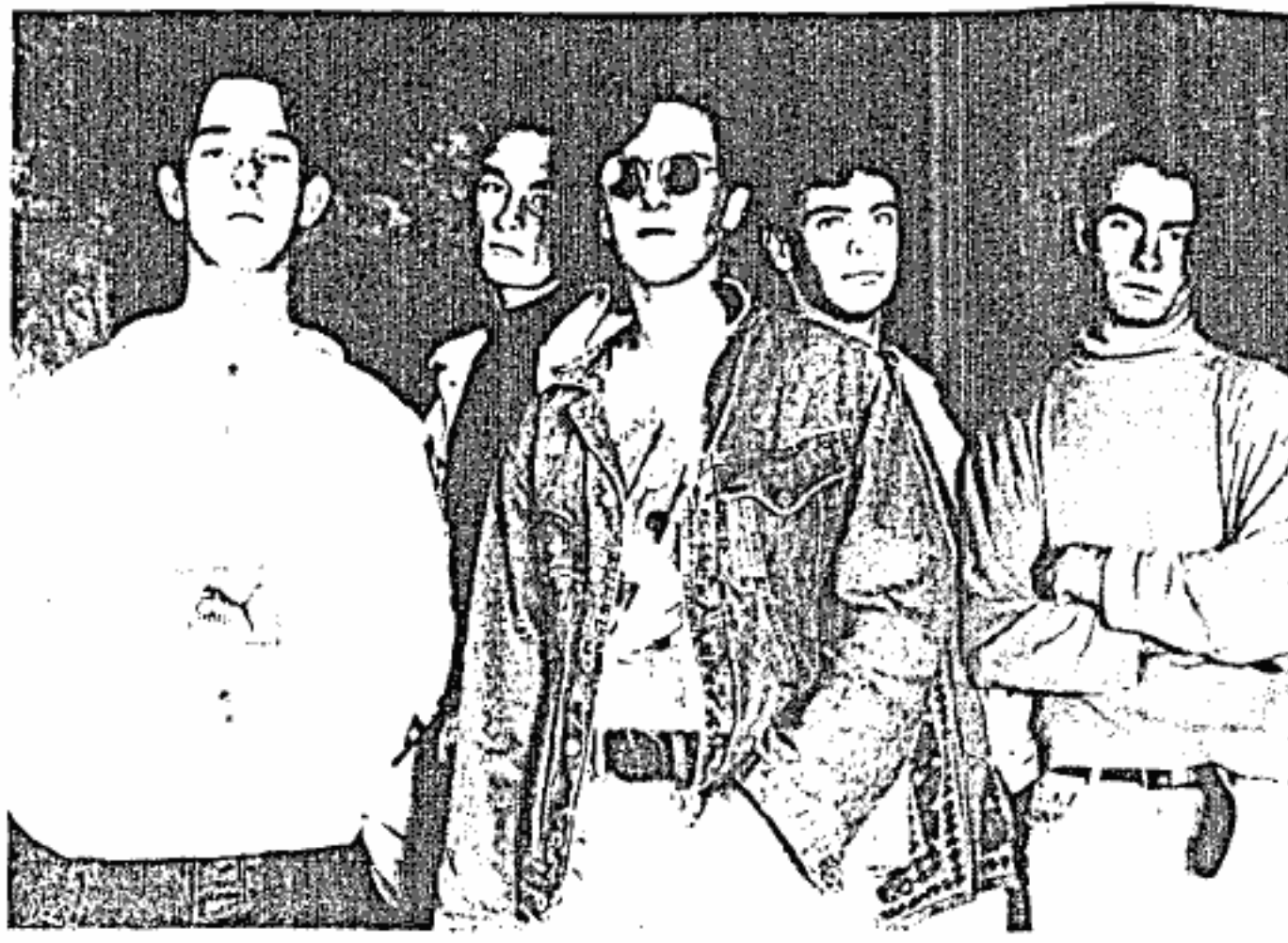
