SAD FAREWELL TO CRANBERRIES SINGER

THE '90s were synonymous with the sound of The Cranberries, especially their hits *Zombie*, *Linger*, *Dreams* and *Ode To My Family*. Tragically, on January 15, their lead singer, Dolores O'Riordan, aged 46, was found dead at a London hotel. The Irish musician and mother of three's sudden death is 'so far being treated as unexplained', according to police. Those close to her spoke about how 'dreadfully depressed' she was in the weeks before her death and was suffering from serious back pain, which had caused her to cancel several gigs in 2017. O'Riordan had a very sad and turbulent past — she was diagnosed as bipolar and spoke of the sexual abuse she had suffered as a child. It haunted her throughout her life as she struggled with drink and drugs to quell her demons and made an attempt on her life in 2013. It was in an interview in 2013 that she revealed that she had been abused as a child, which she said led to her 'anorexia, then depression, then a breakdown'. "I knew why I hated myself. I knew why I loathed myself. I knew why I wanted to make myself disappear." The singer said that her family was her salvation and was devastated at losing her father in 2011, and when her marriage ended in 2014. (Her children went to live in Canada with their father, Don Burton, a former manager of band Duran Duran). In November of that same year, she also admitted to four offences including three assaults and obstructing a garda after being taken off an Aer Lingus flight from New York's JFK airport. Becoming the Cranberries lead singer at just 18, O'Riordan would eventually go on to be a multi award-winning musician, selling tens of millions of records. Band members paid tribute to her on Twitter account, posting: "We are devastated on the passing of our friend Dolores. She was an extraordinary talent and we feel very privileged to have been part of her life from 1989 when we started the Cranberries. The world has lost a true artist today. Noel, Mike and Fergal."
