Launched on Broadway in 1966, it was until 1981 the longest running show on Broadway, having chalked up a run of six years. Limerick audiences are looking forward to renewing acquaintance with this

lavish production, which the Cecilians previously staged in 1973 and 1982.

Producer Joyce Bradford will be producing the show in Limerick for the third time. She has been at the helm for more years than she cares to remember, having previously produced the Cecilians in My Fair Lady (twice); Hello Dolly, Camelot, Kiss Me Kate and the amateur premiere of Seven Brides For Seven Brothers. This time, Miss Bradford is being assisted by Aidan Boucher—a committee member stalwart who has put in a great deal of time and effort on her behalf.

One of the best-known actors in the Cecilians is Joe Donnellan who plays Yevye, while Dundalk lady, Phil O'Neill (a Cecilian for the past fifteen years), plays Golde and is expected to bring a new dimension to the taxing role.

Londoner Dick Wood plays Lazar Wolf, and all the supporting roles have been very carefully cast.
